Whereupon this day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the garnishees appearing and being sworn deposed that they have turned the ^P Edmund Day the sum of five pounds three shillings & six pence of the estate of the defendant payable on the 25th day of December next. & Jacob Norforn that he hath nothing of the ^D defendant's estate. Whereupon it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover of the ^D defendant the sum of two pounds eight shillings (he having proved the same to be just) & his costs by him in this behalf expended & it is ordered that the garnishee pay the sum in his hands to the sheriff & that the ^P sheriff make report of the overplus to the court after satisfying the above judgment & that

Bailey Barnes having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Norforn who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him for a debt due to the said Barnes Benjamin Rufford Sheriff of this county now made return that he has executed the ^P attachment on all the estate of the defendant in the hands of Edmund Day & Jacob Norforn & summons them garnishees. This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the garnishees who being sworn deposed that to wit the ^P Edmund Day that he had the sum of £5. 3. 6 of the estate of the ^D defendant to be delivered to the sheriff to discharge a judgment. Benjamin Norforn son of Robert ^D Benjamin Norforn the def. in this suit & the said Jacob Norforn that he had no effects of this ^D defendant. Therefore it is considered by the court that the ^P plaintiff recover the ^D defendant the sum of two pounds (he having proved the same to be just) & his costs by him in this behalf expended & it is ordered that the sheriff discharge this judgment forth with the money in his hands after satisfaction of Norforn's judgment & make report to the court of his proceedings

Joseph & William Scott having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Norforn who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon for the sum of £19. 10. 6 due to the ^P Joseph & W. Scott Benjamin Rufford Sheriff of this county now made return that he has executed the said attachment on a negro man named Peter of the estate of the ^D defendant. Whereupon this day came the plaintiff by their attorney and the defendant not appearing to reply the attached effects it is considered by the court that they recover against the said defendant the aforesaid sum of nine pounds eight shillings and eleven pence and interest from 24th day of November 1775 till paid & his costs by him in this behalf expended & it is ordered that the sheriff sell the aforesaid mentioned negro Peter at public auction ready money and therewith discharge the aforesaid judgment & forth with report of his proceedings to the next court.
