

John Wilkinson having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Roffey who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Roffey Gent' Sheriff of this County now make return that he had executed the said attachment on the surplus in his hands after satisfaction of Mr Wilkinson & Co's judgment. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of sixteen pounds eight shillings & pence and interest on fifteen pounds five shillings & three pence and farthing from the 26th day of April 1774 till paid of late cost by him in this behalf expended yet it is ordered that the sheriff discharge this judgment & costs with the surplus in his hands of any after discharging Mr Wilkinson & Co's judgment and make report thereof to the court.

William Kirby having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Roffey Gent' Sheriff of this County now make return that he had executed the said attachment on a parcel of hogs & corn land whereupon the defendant not appearing to repley the said attachment stands it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of five pounds & three pence half pence & interest on the same from the 25th day of Oct 1775 till paid of his cost by him in this behalf expended yet it is ordered that the sheriff sell the aforesaid parcel of hogs & the corn at public auction for ready money & with the amount of the sale (together with the expenses after discharging Mr Wilkinson's judgment) discharge this judgment & costs & make report thereof to the court.

Isaac Munford having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so absconded that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Roffey Gent' Sheriff of this County now make return that he had executed the said attachment on all the estate of the said defendant in the hands of Benjamin Wilkinson and Edmund Lom as a garnishee. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the garnishee appearing Young sworn deposes that he hath a grain store upon his frame & two cows of the stock of the said defendant. He not appearing it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of ten pounds eleven shillings & six pence by him in this behalf expended But this judgment except as to the cost is to be discharged by the payment of five pounds eight shillings & one pence Yet it is ordered that the sheriff sell the aforesaid goods at public auction for ready money & therewith discharge this judgment & costs & make report thereof to the court.
