

John Wilkinson having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so abscond that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Ruffin Gent Sheriff of this County now made return that he had executed the said attachment on the surplus in his hands after satisfaction of Dr. Wilkinson & Co's judgment &c This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing, it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of sixteen pounds eight shillings & nine pence and interest on fifteen pounds seven shillings & three pence and costs from the 26th day of April 1775 till paid & his costs by him in this behalf expended It is ordered that the sheriff do change the judgment & costs with the surplus in his hands of any after discharging Dr. Wilkinson & Co's judgment and make report thereof to the court

William Worby having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so abscond that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Ruffin Gent Sheriff of this County now made return that he had executed the said attachment on a parcel of hogs &c and that the defendant not appearing (to reply the said attorney's offer) it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of five pounds & three pence half pence & interest on the same from the 25th day of Decr 1775 till paid & his costs by him in this behalf expended & it is ordered that the sheriff sell the aforesaid parcel of hogs & the first 1st public auction for ready money & with the amount of the sale (together with the surplus after discharging Dr. Wilkinson's judgment) discharge the judgment & costs & make report thereof to the court

John Newsum having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so abscond that the ordinary process of the law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Ruffin Gent Sheriff of this County now made return that he had executed the said attachment on all the estate of the said defendant in the hands of Benjamin Williams and frommond them as a garnishee This day came the plaintiff by ~~his~~ his attorney & the garnishee appearing & being sworn deposed that he hath a griststone upon his frame & two cows of the estate of the said defendant & he not appearing it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the sum of ten pounds eleven shillings & six pence by him in this behalf expended But this judgment except as to the costs is to be discharged by the payment of five pounds eight shillings & nine pence & it is ordered that the sheriff sell the aforesaid griststone & two cows for ready money & therewith discharge this judgment & costs & make report to the court
