

John Norton having obtained an attachment against the estate of Benjamin Newsum who hath privately removed himself or so removed himself that the ordinary process of the Law cannot be served upon him Benjamin Ruffin J^r Gent. Sheriff of this County now made return that he had executed the said attachment in the hands of David Jones & summoned him as garnishee who now appearing & being sworn deposed that he had received a sum from the wife of the said defendant in discharge of a debt of £3. 1. 4 due from the said defendant & the defend^t not appearing Therefore on the motion of the plaintiff by his attorney it is considered by the Court that he recover against the said five pounds eleven shillings & eight pence to be discharged by One pound Five shillings and eleven pence & interest from the 20th day of July 1775 till paid & cost by him to this behalf expended And it is ordered that the garnishee deliver the aforesaid sum to the Sheriff & that he sell the same at public auction for ready money & therewith pay the 3^d garnishee debt of £3. 1. 4 & apply the residue towards satisfaction of this judgment & cost after satisfaction of Jacob Newsums judgment & make report thereof to the Court

Sheriff of this County now made return that he had executed the said attachment on the surplus in the hands of Henry Turner after satisfaction of Vaughans attachment & summoned the 3^d Turner as Garnishee who appeared & being sworn & deposed that he hath a silver watch of the defendants to discharge a debt due him of two pounds two shillings due to him from the 2^d defend^t & he not appearing on the motion of the p^{la} by his attorney it is considered by the Court that he recover against the said defendant the sum of forty pounds ten shillings to be discharged by the payment of twenty pounds five shillings & interest from the 10th day of Feb^r 1772 till paid & cost by him on this behalf expended & it is ordered that the garnishee deliver the aforesaid watch to the Sheriff & that he sell the same at public auction for ready money and therewith discharge the aforesaid judgment & cost or so much thereof as the said writ amount (first paying the garnishee demand of £2. 2.) after satisfaction of Nicholsons judgment & cost &c it is ordered that the Sheriff summon Michael Harris to appear at the next Court as a garnishee &c. — Mem^o M^r Harris app^r in C^t & deposed he had nothing of the defendants yet so that the a^l be done as to him
