due giving security whereupon the P. James Cooper with Thos Cooper his security
entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds
pounds for the P. James due & lawful administration on the P. decedent estate

Ordered that John Hobart, John Mitchell, Henry Davis & William Branch or any
three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in
current money the slaves of any personal estate of Jeppe Johnson and
return the appraisement to the next Court.

Ordered that David Wright Standard Lewis Ethelred Drake & Jas^r Joyner
or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do ap-
praise in current money the slaves of any personal estate of John
Joyner and return the appraisement to the next Court.

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Edm^r Gay was this day
returned & ordered to be recorded.

A writing purporting the last will and testament of Ethelred Taylor was
offered in Court for proof which was opposed by James Taylor
