An Indenture of feoffment from Richard Kello to Micajah Griffin was this day acknowledged by the s^d Kello & ordered to be recorded

An Inventory & Appraisement of the estate of Rob^t. Bailey dead was this day returned & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment from W^m Bryant of the one part to Jonas Bryant of the other part & the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said W^m Bryant & ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of feoffment from Samuel Atkinson & Martha his wife of the one part and Jesse Johnson of the other part was acknowledged by the s^d Samuel & Martha his wife the being first privately examined at the Law direct and ordered to be recorded

Richard Kello esq^r is by the Court appointed guardian to Joseph Mackie orphan of John Mackie dead on his giving security whereupon the s^d Richard Kello with W^m Harris his fec^t enters into & acknowledges their bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for the receiving the s^d orphan's estate and administering the same
