✓ John Cobb is by the court appointed surveyor of the highway on the road of Benjamin Davis who is discharged.

Ordered that Moses Foster & his negroes Simon Jack & Jenny be added to Henry Taylor's lot of lots.

Edwin Gray, Thomas Blunt, & W^m Blunt Gent are by the court recommended to his excellency the Governor as fit and able persons to execute the Office of Sheriff for the ensuing year.

Ordered that the Churchwardens of the parish of Luke bind out Elizabeth Avery orphan of Richard Avery according to Law.

James Ridley and Benjamin Ruffin & Gent are recommended to his excellency the Governor as fit & able persons to execute the office of Coroner for this County.

Ordered that John Wilkinson, William Blunt, John Blunt & John Argon or any two of them do examine state and certify Lucy Stevens account of her guardianship of the orphans of John Eliza died & make upon same to be sent.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in Session.

At a court held for the County of Southampton on Friday the 22^d day of Nov^r 1776 for the trial of John Mecom on suspicion of Murder of Charlotte a negro child belonging to the said Mecom.

The above named John Mecom being committed to the goal of this County charged with the murder aforesaid was led to the bar whereupon divers witnesses appeared to test Thomas Mecom, Benjamin Stewart & James Harting who were present & examined touching the previous & the persons heard in his own defence. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the 2 persons ought to be tried for the 1st offence at the next Court of Oyer & Terminer (or general court as the one may be) & thereupon he is remanded to Goal.
