Whereupon it is ordered that the J^t Colthopt have leave to tract his mill & according to Law.

Charity Collier on behalf of Moody Collier having refused to have the Porphers land in the parish of Noddway proscripted which being duly certified it is therefore ordered that the sheriff of this County in company of an able jury of able freeholders of the J^t County to be summoned by the Sheriff (who is remove force if any shall be need) & sworn before a justice of the peace to do go upon the lands of the J^t Moody Collier which he hath refused to have proscripted as aforesaid & survey and lay off the same according to the most known ancient & reputed bounds thereof Having regard to all patent evidence that shall be produced by the said Charity Collier on behalf of the J^t Moody & it is further ordered that the sheriff return a full & platt record of his proceedings herein to the court & that the said Charity for behalf of the J^t Moody pay the cost of this said survey & proceedings Ordered that Simon Wick be summoned to appear here at the next Court to answer the complaint of his apprentice Henry Marchley exhibited against him for misuswage & that he suffer him to come to the next court to make good his complaint & do not presume to beat or abuse him on this account
