Jacob Summerell came into court and took the oath for a breach of the peace
against Thomas Stevenson Whereupon the said Thomas Stevenson appears
it is ordered that he find security for his good behaviour for the space of
six months & be committed to the custody of the Sheriff till he give such surety
& thereupon the said Tho^s Stevenson with Benjamin Turner his security both
of this County acknowledged themselves indebted to the Commonwealth in the
sum following that is to pay the said Thomas in the sum of fifty pounds & the
said Benjamin in the sum of twenty five pounds of their respective lands &
tenements goods and chattels to be levied & to the said Commonwealth rendered
Yet upon this condition that if the said Thomas shall be of good behavior
towards all the citizens of the s^d Commonwealth but more particularly
towards the said Jacob Summerell then this obligation to be void

John Simmons this day appears & qualified as a Vestryman for the parish of
St Luke & also took the oath of allegiance to the Commonwealth

Ordered that this Court be adjourned till the Court is resumed
at
