An Indenture of feoffment between James Moore & Elisabeth his wife of the one part and Lewis Joyner of the other part was acknowledged by the said James Moore and ordered to be recorded and Elisabeth the wife of the said James personally appeared in court and being first privately examined, as the law directs, voluntarily relinquished her right of dower in the estate conveyed by the said indenture.
