highway from the courthouse to Nottoway swamp in the room of
Robert Barnes who is discharged from that office.

Thomas Mountford is by the court appointed surveyor of the high-
way from Byrps swamp to black creek bridge in the room of
Thomas Sandcocke who is discharged from that office.

Pursuant to law the court doth set the rates of liquors the same
as in March last except Rum @ 20/6^d Gallon & Brandy @ 20/
6^d Gallon.

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay John Simmons
son of Charles Five pounds sixteen shillings and eight pence
for keeping Cary's bridges two years & four months.
