ledged by the said Richard Foster and ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of scoffment between John Reed of the one part  
and Matthew Wills of the other part with the receipt were  
proved by the oaths of Simon Murphy and Thomas Lawrence  
two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

On the motion of Timothy Thorpe who made oath according to  
law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration  
on the estate of Peterson Thorpe decd. If the widow refusing giving  
security Whereupon the said Timothy Thorpe with Philip  
Person his security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in  
the penalty of Ten thousand pounds with condition as the law  
directs for the said Timothy Thorpe due & faithfully admi-  
nistration of the said decedents estate.

Ordered that Arthur Foster Benjamin Lewis, William Miller,  
& Alexander Murry or any three of them being first sworn before  
a justice of the peace of this county do appraise on current money  
the slaves (if any) and personal estate of Peterson Thorpe decd. and
