and Matthew Wills of the other part with the receipt were
proved by the oaths of Simon Murphy and Thomas Lawrence
two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

On the motion of Timothy Thorpe who made oath according to
law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration
on the estate of Peterson Thorpe decd. of the widow refusing giving
securty. Whereupon the said Timothy Thorpe with Philip
Person his securty entered into and acknowledged their bonds in
the penalty of Ten thousand pounds with condition as the law
directs for the said Timothy Thorpe due & faithful admi-
nistrations of the said decedents estate.

Ordered that Arthur Foster, Benjamin Lewis, William Millar,
& Alexander Murry or any three of them being first sworn before
a justice of the Peace of this county do appraise in current money
the slaves / if any / and personal estate of Peterson Thorpe decd. and
