

until he will pay the condemnation of the court or render his body to prison, or discharge thereof or he will do it for him, and the said defendant saving to himself all advantages of exception as well to the jurisdiction of the court as to the declarations of the plaintiff the attachment and proceedings thereon, prays & has leave to impanel all the next court. Whereupon it is ordered that the plaintiff release the attached effects now in his hands and that the cause be continued to a power of attorney from Thomas Ridley to William Hines was proved by the oaths of Jose Dows and J. Gilliom two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

A writ of ad quod daunum with the inquisition thereto annexed for breaking the entail of certain lands in this county the property of Robert Lunniet and Anne his wife, Henry Gilbert & Sarah his wife and Jane Burns was on the motion of the said Lunniet and others ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the court be adjourn'd till court in course.
