On Petition of an act of the General Assembly of the common-
 wealth of Virginia it is ordered that the justices of this county
 make the tour of the said county and tender an oath or affirma-
 tion appointed by the act of assembly in that case made & provide
 to every free born male person above the age of sixteen years caught
 imported servants during the time of their services

On Indictment of felony between Britains Joyner and Fa-
 bitha his wife of the one part and John Drake of the other part
 with the receipt were acknowledged by the said Britains Joyner
 and Fabitha his wife she being first privately examined as the laws
 direct and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke find
 provision for poor Hargrave widow of Michael Hargrave a
 deceased soldier to the amount of three pounds, also for Sally Ho-
 bartons widow of Hartwell Robertsons a deceased soldier to the
 amount of Seven pounds, thirteen shillings & four pence.

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay Robert Hicks
 fourteen shillings and six pence for setting up two sign posts
 with superscriptions.

And all these Present Just Maget Gentlemen
 Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke bind
 out William Adams orphan of Thomas Lumbly dead according
 to law.
