In Pursuance of an act of the General Assembly of the common-
wealth of Virginia it is ordered that the justices of this county
make the tour of the said county and tender an oath or affirma-
tion appointed by the act of Assembly in that case made & provided
to every free born male person above the age of sixteen years caught
imported servants during the time of their service

The Indenture of feoffment between Brittain joyner and Ta-
bitha his wife of the one part and John Drake of the other part
with the receipt were acknowledged by the said Brittain joyner
and Tabitha his wife she being first privily examined as the law
directs and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke find
provision for poor Leargrave widow of Michael Hargrave a
deceased soldier to the amount of three pounds also for Alley Ro-
bertson widow of Hartwell Robertson a deceased soldier to the
amount of Seven pounds, thirteen shillings & four pence.

Ordered that the treasurer ^{pay} of this county pay Robert Risks
seventeen shillings and six pence for setting up two signs posts
with spheres at them.

Given the first instant by George Gentlemen
Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St. Luke bind
out William Lumbly orphan of Thomas Lumbly dead according
to law.
