the vicinage being duly summond & sworn before a Justice of the  
peace, have diligently viewed and examined the lands in the said  
order mentioned, and do report that the acre of land petitioned for  
is of the value of twelve pounds, and that the building thereon will  
be to the damage of John Edwards One hundred & eighty seven pounds  
ten shillings and not to the damage or prejudice of any other person  
or persons whatsoever. Given under our hands & seals this 29<sup>th</sup> day of

have permission to erect his mill according to law.

deed having refused to have the said orphans lands proportioned, an  
order of this court was issued for the surveyor of this county to survey
