freeholders of the county aforesaid being duly summoned by the sheriff  
and sworn before a Justice of the peace did in company with the fore-  
man of the said county go upon the lands on the said order mentioned  
& surveyed & laid off the same agreeable to the surveyors plot & certificate  
which is to this inquisition annexed. In witness whereof as  
well the said sheriff as the jurors aforesaid have hereunto set their  
hands & seals this eighteenth day of June 1777. Signed / Will. Hines depp.

ordered that the Estate of John Meem be assessed for the costs of the said  
survey it appearing to the court that the lines in dispute were de-

and having been before at a court held for this <sup>said</sup> county on the

wife to the said James Ingram who being first specially examined  
as the law directs, is ordered to be recorded.
