An indenture of feoffment between William Bryant of the one part and Benjamin Whitfield of the other part and a memorandum of Liens of Lewis Thomson endorsed were acknowledged by the said William Bryant and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between James Pisk jun^r and Mary his wife of the one part and Samuel Rawlings of the other part with the receipt were acknowledged by the said James Pisk jun^r & Mary his wife she being first lawfully examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

The last will & testament of Thomas Drury dead, was presented in court by Elizabeth Drury the Executrix therein named and proved by the oaths of John Davis & Jacob Joyner two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Elizabeth Drury with Samuel Bond & John Hardy her favorites entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the due & faithful administration of the said decedent's estate & performance of his will.

Ordered that James Pisk, John Garner, James Pisk jr. and Lewis Joyner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the lands (if any) and personal estate of Thomas Drury dead. & return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will & testament of Timothy Atkinson dead, was presented in court by Timothy Atkinson the Executor therein named, and proved by the oaths of William Legabast and John Clayton two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form.
