

A Commission from his Excellency the Governor to William Blunt Gentleman to be Sheriff of this county was produced in court by the said William Blunt and read. Whereupon the said William Blunt together with George Gurley, William Thomas, William Jones and John Wilkenson his friends entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds current money payable & conditioned as in the said condition is directed, and having first taken the oath of office was sworn Sheriff of this county accordingly.

On the motion of William Blunt Gentleman high Sheriff of this county William Jones and Densy Andrews were sworn his under Sheriffs.

John Rogers Gentleman this day appeared and took the oath appointed by a general convention of the delegates as Justice of the Peace & Justice of Oyer & terminer for this county.

The reverend George Gurley is the reverend Henry John ^{Burges} Rogers this day took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth as prescribed by a late act of the general assembly in that case made & provided.

Ordered that the several magistrates of this county provide for and release the widows, wives & children of the soldiers who have died in or are now in the service of the United States, with such necessities as appear reasonable to the said magistrates, having regard to an act of assembly in that case made & provided, and it is further ordered that the clerk make out copies of the above order to the different magistrates of this county.

James Ridley and Edwin Gray Gentlemen are by the court recommended to his Excellency the Governor as fit and able persons to serve as Commissioners for this county.

The last will & testament of Mary Edmunds was presented in court by William & Samuel Edmunds two of the executors therein named & proved by the oaths of John Pike & Samuel Revit two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a Probate thereof in due form giving security otherwise.
