This day came the Plaintiff by his attorney and the garnisher appearing deposed that he hath sufficient in his hands to discharge the plaintiffs debt for Two pounds two shillings & six pence of the estate of the said defendant, and the said defendant not appearing it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said sum of Two pounds two shillings & six pence & his costs by him on his behalf expended, and it is ordered that the garnisher discharge the said judgment & costs.
