Whereupon the said Beverley Booth with Mich. Blon & William Brittle his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds for the true and faithfull administration on the said decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that William Salter, Richard Bailey, Barnaby Bailey & Charles Bailey or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Robert Booth decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.
