Edward Ivey orphan of Joseph Ivey decd. came into court and
chose Henry Ivey for his guardians. Whereupon the said Henry Ivey
with Geo. Ivey his security entered into and acknowledged their bond
in the penalty of five hundred pounds for securing the said
orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

William Blunt one of the persons appointed to let the repairs of the
flat swamp bridge on Craffords road, this day returned their report
in the following words to wit: "In Obedience to an order of South-
ampton court for the repair of the flat swamp bridge on Craffords
road we the subscribers let the repair of said bridge to Cordall
Norfleet for the sum of Two pounds twelve shillings and six
pence, and that the work is now finished according to agree-
ment Jan 4th 1778. Signed. W^m Blunt. Whereupon it is
ordered that the treasurer of this county pay unto the said Cordall
Norfleet the undertaker the said sum of Two pounds twelve
shillings and six pence, and account with the court for the same.

Ordered that Benjⁿ Lewis, John Simons, Charles Barham
and Howell Harris or any three of them let the repairs of the
three creek bridge ^{near of Port} to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof
to this court.

Ordered that Micajah Holliman, Burrell Williamson and
Jesse Carrell or any two of them let the rebuilding of the bridge
over Seawock near N. Washington to the lowest undertaker and
make report thereof to this court.

The last will and testament of Richard Pond decd. was presented
in court by Martha Pond the Executrix and Rich^d Pond and J^r
H. Pond the Executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Joshua
Wood & Mary James two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
and on the motion of the said Executrix and Executors who made oaths
according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat
thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Martha
Pond, Rich^d Pond and J^r H. Pond with James Moore, John
Pond and William Pivey ^{their securities} entered into and acknowledged their
bond in the penalty of Five thousand pounds for the due and
faithful administration of the said decedent's estate & perform
of his will.
