

Ordered that Benjamin Eason, John Cobb, Williams Brown, Joshua Wood or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves and personal estate of Richard Poyd dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

The Inventory & appraisement of the estate of Mary Eason was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of feoffment between John Mannering and Mannering of the one part and Solomon Deloach of the other was proved by the oath of Thomas Nundum, and having been before the 11th day of September 1777 proved by the oaths of William Holt and Horrell Harris two other witnesses thereto is ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Luke Denson one of the people called Quakers made affirmation according to law certificate is granted him obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John Buffin dead. ^(By affidavit refusing) giving security. Whereupon the said Luke Denson with say Johnson his security entered into and acknowledged their in the penalty of One hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the said decedents estate.

Ordered that John Johnson, Lawrence Joyner, Henry Joyner and Charles or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves and personal estate of John Buffin dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

It being represented to this court that several persons in this county have and are about to manumit their slaves, therefore it is ordered that the churchwardens of the parishes of St. Luke and Notton make inquiry concerning the premises and deal with such as the law directs.

An indenture of feoffment with a memorandum of livery & seisin thereon endorsed between Samuel Williford of the one part and John Woodard of the other part was proved by the oaths of Harmon Harris, Benjamin Harris and Jordan Williford three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Morris of the one part and James Morris of the other part was acknowledged and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Francis Buffin Executor of John Buffin dead. of the one part and Richard Harrison of the other part with a memorandum of livery and seisin thereon proved by the oaths of William Unguhart and two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further
