Benjamin Ruffin with William Harris his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One hundred pounds for the
due and faithful administration on the said decedents estate.

Ordered that Thomas Butts, Benjamin Cunn, John Cobb and
Philip Davis or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace of this county do appraise in current the lands if any
and personal estate of Joseph Longworth dead. and return the apprais-
ment to the next court.

Mary Lundy orphan of Bird Lundy dead. came into court and
chose James Lundy for her guardian. Whereupon the said James
Lundy with Lewis Thorpe his security entered into and acknowledge
their bond in the penalty of Two thousand pounds for securing the
said orphans estate and indemnifying the court.

The last will and testament of Sybil Lundy dead. was presented in
court by Phoebe Lundy the Executrix and Lewis Thorpe one of the Executors
therein named, proved by the oaths of Daniel Fisher, William Blau
and John Blaud the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded
and on the motion of the said Executrix and Executor who made
oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining
