

The Indenture of feoffment between Isham Hill and Sarah his wife of the one part and Howell Jones of the other part and a memorandum of livery and seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Isham Hill and Sarah his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

The Indenture of feoffment between Moses Philips and Martha his wife of the one part and Newson Branch of the other part with the receipt was acknowledged by the said Moses Philips and continued for Martha Philips his wife.

The indenture of feoffment between John Hardgrove and Ann his wife of the one part and William Barker of the other part with a memorandum of livery and seisin and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said John Hardgrove and Ann his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Buffkin dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Indenture of feoffment between Thomas Thompson of the one part and Charles Barrett of the other part was proved by the oaths of Arthur Bowing and William Urquhart two of the witnesses thereto and the receipt thereon endorsed was proved by the oath of William Urquhart one of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

William Urquhart's account against the commonwealth for bacon furnished to the amount of Twelve pounds six shillings and ten pence half penny to the widows of Salathiel Lewis a continental soldier is adjudged reasonable.

The last will and testament of Benjamin Withers dead was presented in court by Frederic Withers the Executor therein named proved by the oaths of Henselton Jones and Charles Briggs two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Frederic Withers with Franklin Calath his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for the said Frederic's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate & performance of her will.

Ordered that James Jones, Joshua Wood, Rich^d. Wren and Moses Wood or any three of them being sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Benjamin Withers dead and return the appraisement to the next court.
