

All a court held for the county of Southampton the 19th day of March 1778.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Robert Booth dead was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Nath. Ridley dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of James Wright dead. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Joshua Harris and Olive his wife of the one part and Henry Thomas of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Joshua Harris and Olive his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Matthew Vick sen^r. of the one part and Matthew Vick jun^r. of the other part and a memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Matthew and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Elias Herring, Matthew Smith, Bryant Crumpler, Benjamin Crumpler or any two of them examine state and settle an account current of the estate of James Wright dead. and make report thereof to this court.

On the motion of James Lundy who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Drury Lundy dead. giving security. Whereupon the said James Lundy with Edward Lundy his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Ten thousand pounds for the said James due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate.

Ordered that John Myrick, Thomas Turner, Joseph Reece sen^r. and Moses Thorpe or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Drury Lundy dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of William Twisten dead. was presented in court by Ruth Twisten the Executrix therein named and proved by the oath of William Burden one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Ruth Twisten
