and divided the same by lot as follows to wit: To William Cary Jamie, Ned Daniel, Moses, Nancy, Amey, Ned and Nancy amount three hundred & twenty seven pounds, to Hannah Cary, Robin, Will, Davis, Jacob, Fanny, Jeany Franky, Joly and Bussy amount three hundred & twenty five pounds, to Miles Cary, Pompey, Sam, Joe, Jack, Phillis, Moll, Labell, Molly & Borper amount three hundred and thirty pounds, and to Mary Cary, Mae, Jamie, Ben, Anthony, Joly, Sal, Winney and Belinda amount three hundred and thirty pounds, that Mary Cary pay to William Cary twenty shillings to make up his proportion and to Hannah Cary twenty shillings the remainder what is over and above her proportion, & that Miles Cary pay to the said Hannah forty shillings being what is over and above his proportion to make up the said Hannah's proportion of the slaves aforesaid signed J^{as} Ridley Peter Butts, Arthur Foster. Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the said report be made the judgment of the court in this cause shall be done accordingly.

An Inventory of the Estate of Miles Cary dead, was returned and ordered to be recorded. Ordered that James Ridley, John Sommons, William Hones and Benjamin Clements or any three of them examine state & settle an account current of the estate of Miles Cary dead. & make report thereof to this court.
