

Benjamin Blunts account against the commonwealth for new paid
 widow of Hartwell Robinson to the amount of sixteen pounds seven
 shillings and eleven pence, Ann Hargrave widow of Michael Hargrave
 to the amount of Thirty five pounds eighteen shillings and ten pence, &
 Elizabeth Deane widow of Matthew Deane to the amount of ten shillings
 the whole amounting to Fifty three pounds and nine pence, is adjudged
 by the court to be reasonable, and it is ordered, that the same be satisfied
 in such manner as the law directs.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Benjamin Hittch
 deed. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of William Johnson who made oath according to law
 certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the
 estate of Abby Johnson deed. giving security. Whereupon the said Wm
 Johnson with Moses M^r Henry his security entered into and acknowledged
 their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said William
 due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate.

Ordered that Joshua Nicolson, Amos Harris, John Troup and
 Samuel Westbrooke or any three of them being first sworn before a
 justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the
 slaves if any and personal estate of Abby Johnson deed. and return
 the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Mary Speed deed. was presented in
 court by Isham Hill one of the Executors therein named the other
 being dead, proved by the oaths of William Gresswitt and Samuel Cobb
 two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the
 motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certifi-
 cate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giv-
 ing security. Whereupon the said Isham Hill with Samuel Cobb
 his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty
 of Fifty pounds for the said Isham's due & faithfull administration
 on the the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Henry Briggs, Abraham Mitchell and Henry Cobb &
 William Gresswitt or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
 of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves
 if any and personal estate of Mary Speed deed. & return the appraisem-
 ent to the next court.

An indenture of settlement between Samuel Drenvy of the one part
 and Benjamin Kirby of the other part was acknowledged by the
 said Samuel Drenvy and ordered to be recorded.
