Whereupon the said Cordall Norfleet with William Wyckhart his security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of One thousand pounds for the said Cordall's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Nathan Harris, John Harris, John Blunt and Michael Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Harris dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of feoffment between Cordall Norfleet and Mary his wife of the one part and John Himpred of the other part was acknowledged by the said Cordall Norfleet and Mary his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.
