Ordered that Ben^g. Blunt, John Powell, and Edmund Day or any two of them examine the state and settle an account current of the estate of Michael Bynum dead. and make report thereof to this court.

Samuel Hello produced a commission from his Excellency the Governor to be a Captain of the militia of this county which was read and thereupon the said Samuel Hello having first taken the oath of fidelity to the commonwealth was sworn captain accordingly.

Ordered that Howell Myrick, Jos. Nicolson and Hardy Harris or any two of them let the repairs of Moore's bridge to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court.

Henry Tucker is by the court appointed surveyor of the road in the room of Benjamin Tucker deceased.

Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course.
