The last will and testament of Edward Landy dead. was presented in court by Eliz. Landy the Executrix and William Landy the Executor therein named, proved by the oaths of James Landy and James Landy jun^r and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executrix and Executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Elizabeth Landy and William Landy with John Rogers and Joshua Nicholson their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five thousand pounds for the said Elizabeth's and William's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said deceased and performance of his will.

Ordered that Moses Thorpe, Moses Harris, Thomas Turner and John Myrick or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Edward Landy dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

The indenture of feoffment between Stephen Williamson of the one part and John Wilkinson of the other part and a receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Stephen Williamson and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay unto Robert Jones & Howell Harris the sum of Eight pounds, fifteen shillings and six pence for repairing of Smith's bridge and account thereof with the court.

The account of the administration of the estate of Aaron Thorpe dead. was reported pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.
