Joshua Nicholson's account against the commonwealth for necessities
furnished Elizabeth Brantley widow of a continental soldier for
three pounds, three shillings and one penny is adjudged reasonable
which is ordered to be certified.

James Richs account against the commonwealth for Twenty one pounds
four shillings for 530th of pork furnished the widow of Salathiel
Lewis a continental soldier and Elias Herrings account for two barrells
of corn furnished to the same were adjudged reasonable which is
ordered to be certified.

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Chappell and Mary his
wife of the one part, and Rice B. Paine of the other part, with a me-
morandum of livery of seisin thereon, and a receipt thereon endor-
sed were proved by the oaths of Lewis Joiner jun^r and Samuel Scarborough
two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

An indenture of feoffment between Sarah Nicholson of the one part
and Joseph Nicholson of the other part with the receipt thereon en-
dorsed were proved by the oath of William Moore one of the witnesses
thereto, and having been before proved by the oaths of two other wit-
nesses is ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Jesse Lumbly and Lucy his wife
of the one part, and John Townsend of the other part and a receipt
thereon endor-
sed were proved by the oaths of Thomas Slater and Ben-
jamin Blunt two of the witnesses thereto, and having been before
proved by the oath of another witness, and acknowledged by Lucy
wife to the s^d. Jesse, she being first privately examined as the law
directs are ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Britain Barnes ^{of the one part} and Stephen
Johnson of the other part was proved by the oath of Arthur
Joiner one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved
by the oaths of two other witnesses is ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and appraisement of the Estate of Israel Joiner
did. was returned and ordered to be recorded.
