Ordered that Harris Taylor, John Edwards, Nathani Barnes and James Bryant or any three of them being first sworn before as Justices of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of William Vick dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

Ordered that the churchwardens of the parish of St Luke bind out William Powell orphan of Samuel Powell dead. according to laws
