as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Lewis Joyner is by the approbations of the court and on the motion
of William Blunt Gentleman high sheriff sworn his undersheriff
Ordered that the court be adjourned till the court in course.

Griffin their security entered into and acknowledged their
bond in the penalty of pounds for the due and faithful
administration on the estate of the said decedent and perfor-
mance of his will
