Ordered that Hardy Harris, Timothy Thorpe and Jeremiah Duns or any two of them examined, state and settle an account current of John Turners estate and make report thereof to this court.

On the motion of Rich^d. Hicks he has leave to open the old road from Flowers bridge to the old landing.

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Day and Mary his wife of the one part, and John A. Rogers of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Thomas Day and Mary his wife, she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between James Gray and Rich^d. Gray and Hannah his wife of the one part and Joseph Hart of the other part, and a memorandum of livery of seisin thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of John Hart and William Alkinson two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

Ordered that John Rogers, Samuel Westbrook or any two of them examined, state and settle an account current of the estate of Elias Fort dead. and make report thereof to this court.
