

Stephenson with Benjamin Turner and, Drury Andrews his
jurors acknowledged themselves indebted to the court now sitting
on the behalf of the commonwealth in the sum following that is
to say: the said Thomas in the sum of Five hundred pounds, and
his jurors in the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds each,
upon their respective lands and tenements goods and chattels to
be levied and to the said justices and their successors on behalf of the
commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said
Thomas Stephenson shall be of good behaviour and keep the peace
towards all the inhabitants of this state but more particularly to-
wards the said Mary Stephenson for the space of twelve months
then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force
and virtue.

John Simmons or any two of them let the rebuilding of
Shamrock bridge to the lowest undertaker and make report
thereof to this court.
