workhouse, and that the said Gentlemen employ some person
to keep the said ferry for the space of three months who is to
charge all persons who are not freeholders or inhabitants of the said,
wholly the following prices for crossing viz. for a cart one shilling,
with horse six pence, a man and horse one shilling, a man six
pence, and all four wheel carriages two shillings and each rolling
horsehead tobacco one shilling.

The inventory of the Estate of Thomas Blunt decd. was returned
and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Samuel Bailey who made affirmation according
to law (being one of the people called quakers) administration is
granted him on the estate of David Davis decd. giving security.
Whereupon the said Samuel Bailey with William Holliman
his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the pen-
alty of one thousand pounds for the due and faithfull administra-
tion on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Samuel Bristor, Williams Holliman, Harman Harris,
and James Lancaster, or any three of them being first sworn before a
Justice of the peace for this County do appraise in current money
the Slaves if any & personal Estate of David Davis decd. and return
the Appraisement to the next Court.

The last will and testament of Benjamin Clements decd. was
presented in court by Benjamin Clements and Thomas Clements the
executors therin named, proved by the oaths of John Trigett, John
Brown and Thomas Peete the witnesses thereto and ordered to be record-
ed. And on the motion of the said Executors who made oath
according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat
thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Benya-
min and Thomas Clements with Charles Briggs and Thomas
Ridley their securities entered into and acknowledged their
bond in the penalty of Twenty thousand, pounds current money
of Virginia for the said Benjamin and Thomas's due and
faithfull administration of the said decedent's estate and
performance of his wills.

Ordered that Daniel Bulekings, William Lines, Benjamin
Turby and William Foster or any three of them being first sworn
before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current
money the slaves if any and personal estates of Benjamin Clem-
ents decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.
