The last will and testament of John Rawlings decd. was presented in court by Isaac Rawlings and Thomas Adams the Executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Richard Mason, Geo. Bell and Henry Ivy the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Isaac Rawlings and Thomas Adams with Joshua Nicholson and Ben^y Adams their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds current money of Virginia for the said Isaac and Thomas' due and faithful administration of the said decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that Joshua Thorpe, Henry Ivy, Henry Appleswhite and Matthew McHenry or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the lands if any and personal estate of John Rawlings decd & return the appraisement to the next court.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of William Rawlings decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An Inventory and appraisement of the estate of the estate of Drury Lundy decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Thomas Clements Gilliam orphan of John Gilliam decd. came into court and chose Thomas Gilliam for his guardian. Whereupon the said Thomas Gilliam with Arthur Foster and John Simmons his securities entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of Three thousand pounds current money of Virginia for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

John Andrews is by the court appointed guardian to Benjamin Andrews orphan of Robert Andrews decd. Whereupon the said John Andrews with Drury Andrews his security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of one thousand pounds for securing the said orphan's estate and indemnifying the court.

Ordered that John Thomas Blon, Thomas Edmunds and William Thomas or any two of them let the building of a bridge over Potomac river at the courthouse to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court.
