Signed/ Peter Butts, Benjamin Ruffin. Whereupon it is ordered that the treasurer of this

county pay unto the said Thomas Clements the undertaker the said sum of Thirty pounds and account thereof with the court.

Ordered that Charles Cosby, Moses Phillips and Thomas Lane or any two of them let the repairing of the causeway over round hill swamp to the lowest undertaker and make report thereof to this court.
