

On the motion of William Mops who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Henry Mops decd. giving security whereupon the said William Mops with John Simmons his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds current money of Virginia for the said William's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Henry Westbrooke, Thomas Giddions junior, Howell Harris and Joshua Fort or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for this county to appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Henry Mops decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

For indenture of poffment and surrender between Jacob Barnes of the one part and Thomas Holliday of the other part was and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Jesse Dren and William Thomas two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

Ordered that Mathew Wills, Joseph Johnson, & Job Wright or any two of them view a bridge below Capt. Jones mill and make report thereof to this court.

The last will and testament of James Moore decd. was proved by the oaths of Benjamin Bell and Elipha Lewis two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Isaac Williams and Jesse Williams who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said James Moore with the said will annex'd (the executors therein named refusing the burthens of the executions thereof) giving security whereupon the said Isaac Williams and Jesse Williams with Rich^d. Hicks & Jordan Denson their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of ten thousand pounds for the said Isaac and Jesse's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate & performance of his will. Ordered that Thomas Baits, Samuel Drenory, John Vicks or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any & personal estate of James Moore decd. & return the appraisement to the next.
