been better proved by the oaths of two other witnesses so ordered to be
recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Christopher Wade of the one
part and James Wilson of the other part and a receipt thereon
endorsed were acknowledged by the said Christopher Wade and
ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Williamson of the one
part and Thomas Clements Butts of the other part, a memoran-
dum of livery of seisin and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved
by the oaths of Micajah Holloman and Drury Andrews two of the
witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

A Deed in trust between Jacob Williams of the one part and
Edward Britt of the other part was proved by the oaths of Micajah
Holloman and Drury Andrews two of the witnesses thereto and
ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of John Philips deceased was presented
in court by Joseph Philips the Executor therein named, proved by
the oaths of Howell Jones and Edwin Tunnebrow two of the wit-
nesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of
the said Executor who made oath according to law certificated is
granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form
giving security. Whereupon the said Joseph Philips with
Nathaniel Coker his security entered into a acknowledgement
