An indenture of feoffment between Thomas Williamson of the one part and Thomas Clements Beatts of the other part, a memorandum of livery of seisin and a receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Micajah Holloman and Drury Anderson two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

A Deed in trust between Jacob Williams of the one part and Edward Britt of the other part was proved by the oaths of Micajah Holloman and Drury Anderson two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of John Philips decd. was presented in court by Joseph Philips the Executor therein named, proved by the oaths of Howell Jones and Edwin Turnebro two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat^e thereof in due form giving security.
