

Ordered that Cordall Norflet, John Harris, John Crawford & 49
Thomas Suter or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves
if any and personal estate of Hardy Beale dead, and return the
appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Williams Beale dead, was presented
in court by William Beale one of the executors therein named,
proved by the oaths of Benjamin Beale and John Drake two
of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the mo-
tion of the said executors who made oath according to law certi-
ficate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form
giving security. Whereupon the said William Beale with
Richard Beale and Benⁿ. Beale his securities entered into
and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand
pounds for the said Williams due and faithfull administra-
tion of the estate of the ^{d.} decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that David Wright, Williams Williams, Jonas Edwards
and John Drake or any three of them being first sworn be-
fore a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in
current money the slaves if any and personal estate of William
Beale dead, and return the appraisement to the next court

Priscilla Beale, widow of W^m. Beale dead, came into court
and refused to accept of the legacy given her in the will of
her said deceased husband, and renounced all benefit thereby.

The last will & testament of Leonard Oney dead, was presented in
court by Thomas Oney the executor therein named, proved by
the oaths of Nathaniel Coker and Arthur Exum the witnesses
thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the
said executor who made oath according to law certificate is
granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giv-
ing security. Whereupon the said Thomas Oney with Nathaniel
Coker his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in
the penalty of two thousand pounds for the said Thomas due
and faithful administration of the estate of the said decedent
and performance of his will.
