On the motion of Mary Adams who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Robert Adams dead giving security. Whereupon the said Mary Adams with John Adams her security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Four hundred pounds for the said Mary's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent.

Ordered that Rice B. Pierce, James Garrity, Jos. Calk and Wm. Spivy jun^r or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Mary Adams dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

The last will and testament of Samuel Johnson dead. was presented in court, proved by the oaths of Henry Pope and Hardy Pope two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded; And on the motion of John Johnson who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration ^{with the will annexed} on the estate of the said decedent giving security. Whereupon the said John Johnson with Giles Johnson the Executor in the said will named (refusing to qualify). Whereupon the said John Johnson with Giles Johnson & John Luter his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of One thousand pounds for the said John's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.

Ordered that Hardy Pope, John Council, Micajah Griffin & Williams Barrett or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Samuel Johnson dead. and return the appraisement to the next court.

An indenture of covenant between Arthur Joyner of the one part and Isaac Williams of the other part and a receipt thereto were proved by the oaths of Silas Kirby, James Williams and Elias Williams three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
