The last will and testament of Robert Jones decd. was presented in court by John Simmons one of the Executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Benjamin Barham and David Jones two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Simmons with James Jones and Joshua Nielson his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Twenty thousand pounds for the said John's due and faithful administration on the said decedent's estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that Thomas Fitzhugh, Jeroniah Dren, Timothy Thorpe and William Turner or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Robert Jones decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

On the motion of John Luter who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Thomas Luter decd. giving security. Whereupon the said John Luter with John Johnson & Giles Johnson his securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said John's due & faithful administration on the said decedent's estate.
