

Ordered that John Sumnerell, John Clayton, James Sumnerell and Abalom Williamson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of James Niblett. decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

For indentures of feoffment between Daniel Pond of the one part and Richard Pond senior of the other part was acknowledged by the said Daniel Pond and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Elias Herring, Hardy Pope, Simon Johnson and John Johnson or any two of them examine, state and settle and ascertain current of the estate of Thomas Lister decd. and make report thereof to this court.

The last will and testament of Richard Ricks decd. was presented in court by John Thomas Blow, William Thomas, Robert Ricks, Richard Ricks & Joseph Ricks the executors therein named proved by the oaths of Isaac Williams and John Ridgwood two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motions of the said executors who made oath according to law certificates is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said John Thomas Blow, William Thomas, Robert Ricks, Richard Ricks and Joseph Ricks with Samuels Edmunds, Richard Telle and Henry Briggs their securities entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of One hundred thousand pounds for the said executors due and faithfull administration of the said decedents estate and performance of his will.

Ordered that Isaac Williams, Benjamin Williams Lewis Popper and John Johnson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Richard Ricks decd. and return the appraisement to the next court.

A Release from Thomas Lane to Nathaniel Felts was acknowledged by the said Thomas Lane and ordered to be recorded.

For indentures of feoffment between Burrell Williamson of the one part and Benjamin Harris of the other part was acknowledged by the said Burrell Williamson and ordered to be recorded.

A Deed of gift from Thomas Greenham to Jane Greenham was proved by the oaths of Nicholas Maget and Jacob Scorer two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.
