

Ordered that Joshua Nicolson, Owen Myrick, Richard Johnson ⁸⁹ and John Foot or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this county do appraise in current money the Flaves of any and personal estate of Sampson Pursum dead, and return the appraisement to the next court.

An Inventory of the estate of Joseph Reese dead, was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between Franklin Clark and Mary his wife of the one part and John Sykes of the other part was acknowledged by the said Franklin Clark and Mary his wife she being first privily examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An account current of the administration of the estate of Mary Edmunds dead, was reported pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between John Drake of the one part and Elijah Pope of the other part was proved by the oaths of Samuel Edmunds and John Wilkinson two of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

The last will and Testament of William Turner dead, was presented in court by Benjamin Turner and Littleton Turner the executors therein named, proved by the oaths of Jacob Barnes and Sarah Barnes two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said Executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Benjamin Turner & Littleton Turner with Howell Myrick, Mark Nicolson and Thomas Turner their securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of forty thousand pounds for the said Executors due and faithful administration of the said decedents estate and performance of his will.

An indenture of feoffment between John Thomas Bloo, William Thomas, Robert Nicks, Richard Nicks and Joseph Nicks Executors of Richard Nicks dead of the one part and Elizabeth Edwards of the other part, and the receipt thereon endorsed were for acknowledged by the said William Thomas, Rob^t. Nicks, Rich^d. Nicks for Nicks and ordered to be recorded.
