

in the sums following that is to say the said Benjamin in the sum of one thousand pounds and the said Jesse and Elias in the sum of five hundred pounds each, to be levied of their respective lands, tenements, goods and chattels, and to the said commonwealth rendered, left upon this condition that if the said Benjamin truly shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the inhabitants of this state, but more particularly towards the said Benjamin Odon, willy for the space of twelve months then this obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

The persons appointed to view the bridge lately erected over Rottonay river near this place this day made their report in the following words to wit:.

Pursuant to an order of court bearing date 11th. Nov. 1779. We the subscribers have viewed the bridge built across Rottonay river near the court house by Capt. Jesse Whitehead and find the bridge to be built near 2 feet higher at each end, that it was let to be built otherwise completed according to agreement. Signed / Tho. Edmonds, Wm. Thomas. Whereupon it is ordered that the Treasurer of this county pay unto Jesse Whitehead the undertaker the sum of two hundred and ninety eight pounds fifteen shillings for the same, and account thereof with the court.

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Samuel Johnson decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Inventory and appraisement of the estate of Williams Beale decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

An account current of the administration of the estate of Thomas Luter decd. was reported pursuant to the order of this court and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between William Titching and Martha his wife of the one part and Christians Denson of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said William Titching and Martha his wife she being first privately examined and the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of feoffment between John Speed of the one part and William Edwards of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oath of William Urquhart one of the witnesses thereto and continued for further proof.

The inventory and appraisement of the estate of Peterson Thoppe decd. was returned and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that Thomas Langfort, Joseph Mountford & Shadrach Lewis or any two of them examine, state and settle an account of the estate of Williams Beale decd. and make report thereof to this court.
