Upon the presentment of the grand Jury against John Adams for gaming. This day came the attorney for the commonwealth and the defendant having confessed himself guilty in manner and form as in the presentment is alleged, therefore it is considered by the court that he make his fine with this our commonwealth by payment of Five pounds and the costs of this prosecution & the said defendant may be taken &c.

On information by John Mitchell against Henry Adams & Will. Moore for gaming at the ordinary at this place the defendants appeared and confessed the fact, whereupon it is ordered that they make their fine with this our commonwealth by payment of Five pounds each and the costs of this prosecution and it is further ordered that they find security for their good behaviour. Whereupon the said Henry Adams and Will. Moore with John Adams and Thomas Ridley their sureties both of this county acknowledged themselves bound unto the commonwealth of Virginia in the sums following that is to say the said Adams & Moore in the sum of one hundred pounds each and their sureties in the sum of Fifty pounds each to be levied of their respective lands, tenements goods and chattels and to the use of the said commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Adams & Moore shall be of good behaviour for the space of twelve months then their obligation to be void, else to remain in full force & virtue.
